Max Wide, Interim Executive Director for Organisational Development, London Borough of Barnet

Biography to follow



Councillor Richard Stay, Deputy Leader, Central Bedfordshire Council

Richard is the Deputy Leader of Central Bedfordshire and holds the Portfolio for Business Transformation. Central Bedfordshire is a new Unitary, formed in April 2009 as a result of local government reorganisation. He previously served as Deputy Leader with the Finance Portfolio at Bedfordshire County Council for 12 years and stood as the Conservative Parliamentary Candidate in Luton South in 2005. Richard is also a Director of the Leadership Centre for Local Government, a Member of the LGA Improvement Board, Chairman of Improvement East RIEP and a CAA Lead Peer for the Audit Commission. As Chairman of the RIEP for the East of England Richard has been closely engaged with the National Forum that meets and liaises with Ministers around the Total Place pilots.



Chris Leslie, Director, New Local Government Network

Chris Leslie is the Director of New Local Government Network, leading their work as an all-party not-for-profit public policy thinktank since 2005. He was previously a Government Minister at the Department for Constitutional Affairs (2003 to 2005) with responsibility for the courts and elections policy. Chris piloted the Constitutional Reform Bill through the House of Commons, creating a new Supreme Court for the United Kingdom, which opened in 2009. Prior to this, Chris was the Parliamentary Under Secretary of State at the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister (2002 to 2003) with responsibilities for local government and regions policy. His first ministerial post was at the Cabinet Office (2001 to 2002) heading up civil service policy matters, civil contingencies and emergency planning. He was elected Member of Parliament for the Shipley constituency in May 1997 and was re-elected in June 2001, serving two whole terms (until the May 2005 General Election). From 1994 to 1998, Chris was a councillor on Bradford City Council. He currently serves as a Trustee of the Consumer Credit Counselling Service and debt charity Credit Action.



Damian Roberts, Director of Strategy & Communications, London Borough of Croydon

Damian Roberts is Director Strategy & Communications at the London Borough of Croydon which is one of the 13 national pilots for Total Place. His responsibilities include the development of Croydon's award winning Local Strategic Partnership, the co-ordination of their Local Area Agreement, and the creation of a new 30 year vision for the borough and the rollout of Total Place thinking within the Council and the Local Strategic Partnership. Damian's previous roles at Croydon have included Director of Transformation and ICT, and Director of Partnerships, Business and Community. Before that he was Head of Corporate Strategy and Equalities at Tower Hamlets Council. Damian was also Head of Strategy and Performance at Islington Council.



Ken Davis, Head of Assessment, Audit Commission

Ken is the Head of Assessment for the Audit Commission in London region. He is responsible for the delivery of Comprehensive Area Assessment in London. He has been a senior manager at the Commission for the last six years. Before that he was a management consultant for six years and worked at five local authorities for the 17 years before that – 2 London Boroughs and three County Councils, ending up as a corporate director.

His background is in policy development, performance management and strategic planning.

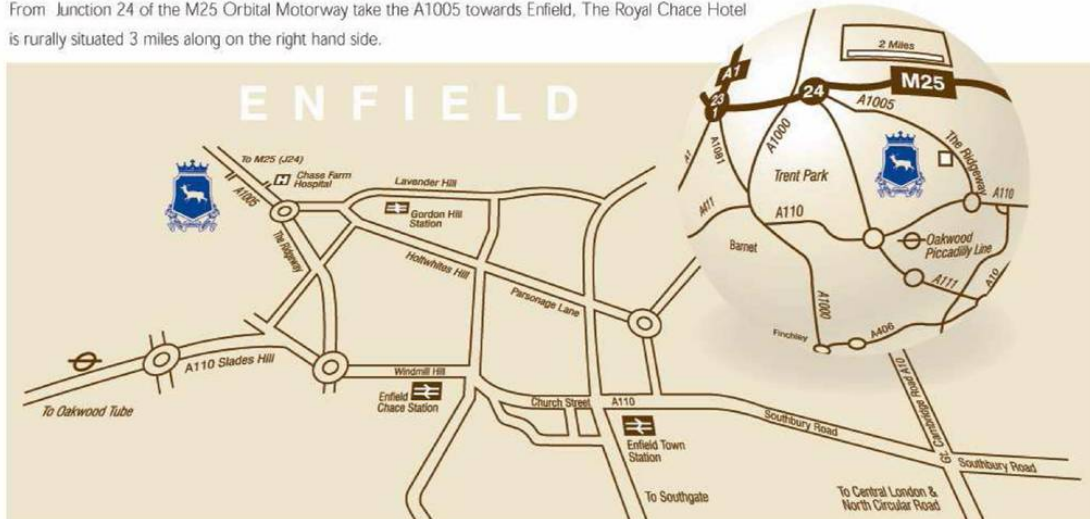

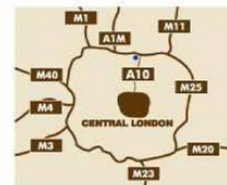
